The Graduate Handbook and University rules define satisfactory progress as follows:

- a. Graduate students are ordinarily expected to complete at least six credits of coursework each semester in which they are enrolled until all required **coursework** is completed;
  - b. Students should have no more than seven deferred or incomplete credits in courses other than thesis or dissertation credit;
  - c. Students should have filed an approved Grad Plan by the beginning of their **2nd year** in the graduate program (this is a University requirement);
  - d. Students should have had their Qualifying Paper approved by the **end of 4 semesters** in the program and must have made an oral presentation no later than the **fifth semester**;
  - e. Students should complete comprehensive exams within **4 years** of entering the graduate program;
  - f. Students should have filed an approved dissertation proposal within **1 year** of passing their comprehensive exams;
  - g. The Ph.D. degree should be completed within **6 years** of initial enrollment in the graduate program;
  - h. The Ph.D. degree should be completed within **3 years** of passing comprehensive examinations.
- Ph.D. candidates must have at least a 3.00 grade point average in the degree program;
  - Ph.D. candidates cannot have grades below 3.00 (including N grades in the P-N grading system) in more than two semester courses required by the guidance committee.
