GREECE EDUCATION ABROAD, SUMMER 2020

INFORMATION SESSION on Wednesday, November 13, 2019 in Room 117 Berkey Hall at 7:00pm.

The program is held on the beautiful Greek island of Lesbos (see: <http://lesvos.com/>) also called Mytilene, in the Eastern Aegean Sea, an ideal location for a 6-week summer study abroad program experience.

Classes taught by MSU Faculty: Integrative Studies (ISS315 (global diversity) and Sociology (SOC100 (Intro), and SOC496/7/8/ (Ind. Research and Internships)).

Students can now gain formal international internship experience (through SOC498, a 3-credit internship class) working with unaccompanied minors and women refugees in two refugee camps on the island of Lesbos, which is now home to 15000+ refugees who have fled from Syria, Iraq, and Afghanistan.
