

How to be Eligible:

- Download the <u>MSU Civic Life App</u> on your smart phone or tablet, or <u>visit msuciviclife-prod.azurewebsites.net to log your hours online</u>
- Update your profile and input your qualifying hours by December 9, 2022.
- All students who update their profiles within the app with 100 or more hours will be eligible for the award

What Counts Toward the Award

There are many ways of community engagement, **not just volunteering**, that counts toward the 100 hours necessary to be eligible for the SVSA. Your hours can be from during the semester, over the summer, at home, abroad, or on campus at MSU!
